Pitch Perfect	Students will learn about sale and marketing and how the skills we teach in English transfer to these careers. Students will be give an 'unsellable' pointless item to create a sales pitch for.

DIY Sports: Design it, play it	Design a new sport with assigned equipment, show it to the rest of the group, play the best one.	
Death on the track	Using different mathematical skills to discover who the murderer is.	
Personal Plaques	Students will create bright and colourful plaques using collage that say something about who they are. They will take these home as personal plaques or gifts for someone they care about.	
Design with AI	An exploration activity that covers uses/limitations of using AI. Let's Play Golf 1	Using shapes, area, scale and financial maths to plan and design a mini gold hole.	
Ancient Myths & Gods	Work in a team to research and create an academic poster on the gods and myths of Ancient History.	
Volcano, Oobleck and tea lanterns	Building volcanoes, investigating oobleck and non-newtonian fluids, making tea lanterns to see how thrust is produced in tea lanterns.	
Build-A-Biome	We'll be running a hands-on 'Build a Biome' project. using recyclables or unwanted craft supplies students will build creative and eco-friendly models of their favourite biomes.	
Earthquake Disaster	In the Minecraft Education lessons students take on the role of an RAF disaster relief team member tasked with providing aid to an area devastated by an earthquake.
